### Veterans Memorial Park Memorial Program

Veterans Memorial Park has become the place in Hillsborough County to visit and pay tribute to military heroes as well as many military families and friends.

Hundreds of individual and organizational memorials are located throughout the Memorial Plazas of the park, most of which were placed during the construction phase of the plazas, ending with the dedication of the Iraq Memorial in 2016. In the meantime, hundreds more have been added to honor family and friends, as well as the numerous organizations who are part of the Hillsborough County veteran community.

Hillsborough County and a local non-profit have made arrangements to continue placement of new individual memorials throughout the park grounds, but in order for these memorials to be properly installed, a comprehensive plan was enacted to offer features consistent with those of existing memorials.


This brochure explains the process for individual memorial requests, the features that are available and how to place an order for an individual memorial.

In general, the majority of memorials are Clay Bricks, Black Granite Plaques and Black Granite Benches. In addition, there are several locations on the grounds where on-site engraving is allowed. Details are provided per type of memorial requested.

Inside this brochure is an order form to help you choose a memorial selection; the specific colors available, the location of the memorial; and a pricing guide. A QR Code is provided that links to additional information and a printable form.


